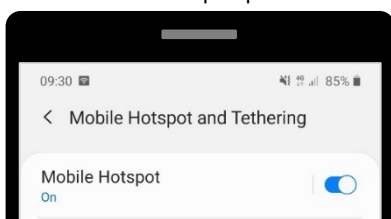
Live Navigation

Using Smartphone tethering

If your vehicle is not equipped with a Connect Box, you may still be able to benefit from the Live Navigation feature. To do so, you will need to tether your smartphone to your car using it as a Wi-Fi hotspot as detailed below, as well as activating the Live Navigation service in the Vauxhall Connect site.

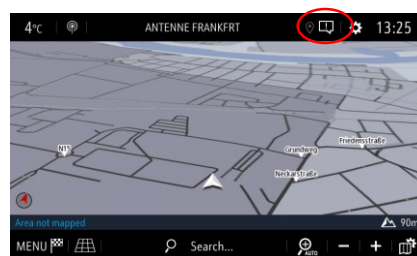
Start your vehicle and wait until the infotainment system is fully activated – this may take a few seconds.

- 1** Activate the hotspot function in the settings of your smartphone and check the hotspot password.

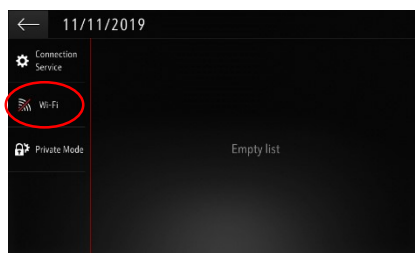


- 2** Start your vehicle and wait until the infotainment system is fully started. Ensure you are in an area with GSM network coverage (avoid for example underground car parks, etc.).

- 3** Tap on the messages icon on the upper right of the navigation screen.



- 4** Select "Wi-Fi". The vehicle will now search for available hotspots.



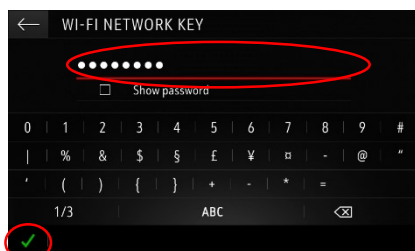
- 5** Should the name of your device not be listed, restart the search by tapping on the update button.



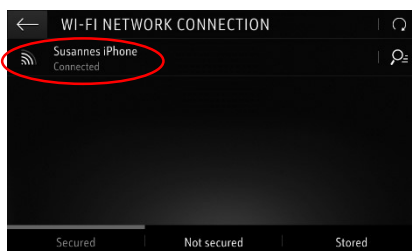
- 6** The found hotspots will be displayed. Tap on the name of your device and ...



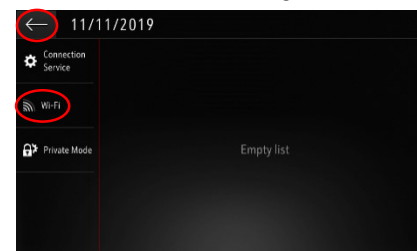
- 7** ... enter the hotspot password from your smartphone (see step 1). Tap the green tick to confirm.



- 8** When the connection has been established successfully, the Device will be shown as connected.



- 9** The infotainment system will now use the mobile data of the connected device. Tap the back icon to return to the navigation screen



Note: Using connected navigation features consumes mobile data. Additional costs may apply.
